Gulf Coast Educators FCU Announces 2021 Scholarship Recipients

Pasadena, TX: On April 5, 2021, Gulf Coast Educators FCU announced this year's scholarship recipients. According to a report provided by the College Board, the average yearly cost of attending a four-year public college is \$10,560.

To help alleviate some of the costs for their members the credit union awards scholarships annually in the amount of \$500 per semester for four years- a total of \$4,000 goes to four qualifying students selected from applicants within their field of membership. This year the credit union received 34 applications from high school seniors all over the greater Houston area. The following students were recipients of the scholarship award:

To qualify for the scholarship the applicant must be a high school senior. The students must also be a member in good standing with GCEFCU along with their parent/guardian. Two scholarships are awarded to students pursuing a degree in the field of education, and the other two to applicants outside the teaching field.
