Gulf Coast Educators FCU Employees Donate Over \$11K to Local Charities

Pasadena, TX: During the 2017 year, the employees at Gulf Coast Educators Federal Credit Union were able to donate over \$11,000 to local charities in need. Many of Gulf Coast Educators FCU's employees participate in the credit union's Employee Giving Program. The employees elect to donate a few dollars of their paycheck every month to go towards charities in the greater Houston area.

In return for their generosity, GCEFCU allows the participating employees to wear jeans on Fridays. In 2017, the credit union had over 113 employees participating in the program.
