Gulf Coast Educators FCU & Employees Donate Over \$200k To Schools & Charities

Pasadena, TX, February 7, 2020: During the 2019 year, Gulf Coast Educators Federal Credit Union and their employees were able to donate over \$200,602.49 to education and local charities in need. Every year the credit union donates thousands of dollars to schools in form of donations, classroom grants, teaching awards, and scholarships.

In addition, many of Gulf Coast Educators FCU's employees participate in the credit union's Employee Giving Program. The employees elect to donate a few dollars of their paycheck every month to go towards charities in the greater Houston area. In return for their generosity, GCEFCU allows the participating employees to wear jeans on Fridays. In 2019, the credit union had over 131 employees participating in the program.
