## Gulf Coast Educators FCU Donates \$5K To Education Foundations

Pasadena, TX: On December 7, 2020, the following school districts were announced as the winners of Gulf Coast Educators FCU Education Foundation Giveaway. Pasadena ISD was named first place winner with a total of 2,336 vote earning them a grand prize of \$2,500. Humble ISD followed in second place with a total of 270 votes winning them \$1,500. Last, but certainly not least, Dickinson ISD came in third place with 194 votes and a prize of \$1,000. Each education foundation was presented with a check to use towards their district.

The giveaway, which ran from November 17- 30, 2020 allowed educators, school employees, parents, and community members to nominate their education foundation by completing a form on the GCEFCU website. The nominations were then sorted and tallied to determine each first, second, and third place winners.

Education foundations are composed of volunteers that are continuously thinking of new ways to give back to their schools and teachers. Through their fundraising and charity efforts, they support teachers, students, and schools. Gulf Coast Educators FCU values the purpose and work that education foundations do for their communities and wanted to give back to the organizations that give so much to educators.
